Carmila State School will receive

**\$13,950\***

## This funding will be used to

- Use targeted personnel and resources to move a C to B, and a B to an A in English and Math. **English 26.3% of students are receiving a C and 47.4% of students are receiving a B. In Math 47.4% of students are receiving a C and 36.8% of students are receiving a B.**
- Build a bank of resources and lessons aligned with the Numeracy Continuum across the clusters, and number sense and algebra areas. These lessons are designed for students requiring learning support and/or extension in numeracy.
- Intensive Speech and Language Therapy to teach the fundamentals of communication – with the main focus on forming words and sounds, and co-ordinating facial movements in the Early Years.

## Our initiatives include

- Literacy groups [P-2 and 3-6] to build writing stamina in our students, staff capability and consistency of language across the school
- Mini + MAQ Lit reading intervention and extension program
- Numeracy extension and support groups
- Speech Therapy and Intervention support for targeted students from K-6
